



## Consent Project Manager

Dublin Rape Crisis Centre (DRCC) is a non-governmental organisation, registered as a charity, which specialises in the treatment and support of victims/survivors of sexual violence and advocates for full recognition of their rights within our justice, health and education systems.

Dublin Rape Crisis Centre is developing a project, as part of our wider consent work, which will change our society's understanding and attitude towards consent and healthy sexual relationships. At the moment around 1 in 5 Irish people think sex without consent is OK in some circumstances. Our campaign will change that.

This work, which will draw on DRCC's expertise, new research and the insights of survivors will engage with communities and lead a change in Ireland's approach to consent, sexual equality and sexual violence. This project will build a national conversation on consent, develop and deliver programmes to explore the issues around consent and deliver a public campaign grounded in human rights.

The Project Manager will be responsible for developing the vision of the project, leadership, communications, management and administration, finance and fundraising.
