- Provide supervision in accordance with the values of DRCC and accrediting bodies.

- Must currently have and maintain active accreditation with relevant body IACP/IAHIP
- Must have excellent experience working therapeutically and in a supervision capacity with traumatic material, mental health presentations and sexual violence.
